- The 2021 Citizenship Awards are based on student involvement in citizenship-related activities during the period covering Term 4 in 2020 and Terms 1-3 in 2021.
- The Citizenship Awards are presented to students who participate in a range of extra curricula or cocurricular school activities including Anzac Day, student breakfasts such as NAPLAN, and Student Council activities.
- A Citizenship Award is presented on the achievement of criteria in the areas of contribution, leadership, recognition, representation.
- Your Year Level HOD/s will review all nominations and award points using the criteria below.
- Activities eligible for consideration include but are not limited to:
 - Anzac Day March
 - Harmony Week
 - Student Breakfasts e.g. NAPLAN
 - Student Council Activities e.g. Shave for a Cure
 - Parent Information Evenings
 - Relay for Life
 - Voluntary pursuits

Leadership refers to the level of responsibility or type of tasks students have demonstrated in addition to that of attendance. This may include self-leadership in terms of commitment to practice, self-organisation, self-discipline, use of respectful communication and reliability. Leadership can also relate to responsibility for others or the completion of tasks that contribute to the success of the overall project or team.

Process Steps

- 1. Complete nomination form
- 2. Submit nomination form to Student Services by end of Week 8, Term 3 2021.
- 3. Nomination forms reviewed by panel
- 4. Nominations assessed and overall points awarded by the panel
- 5. Interviews conducted to determine over all Gold Award one Senior and one Junior
- 6. Distinction awards determined.

Nominations must be submitted to your Year Level HOD by 3 September 2021.
