GOLD AWARD SPORT DISTINCTION TOP OF YEAR - OVERALL

- 2021 Sporting Awards celebrate student involvement. Leadership and excellence in Sport related activities during the period covering Term 4 in 2020 and Terms 1-3 in 2021.
- Sport Awards are presented to students who participate in a range of extracurricular or co-curricular sporting activities.
- There are three levels of Sporting Awards - Gold, Distinction and a Top of Year Overall.
- The **Gold** Sporting Award is for leadership and outstanding achievement. This is awarded on the highest overall points, final portfolio and interview (if shortlisting is required). Students need to submit a written application consisting of three questions and answer these questions for consideration of this award.
- Sport **Distinction** Awards are determined based on levels of; participation, contribution, leadership, recognition, representation of the school in events and achievement of excellence.
- **Top of Year** overall is based on the highest number of points attained by an individual per year level.

Three levels of Sporting Awards

- Top of year Sport Award - Overall
- Distinction Sport Awards → Year 7 - 12
- Gold Sport Award – awarded to one student only.

Process Steps

1. Complete the nomination form for the opportunity of a Distinction Award, Gold Award & Top of Year Overall
2. Submit nomination form to the **MPS DROP BOX: By Friday 10th September.**
3. Awards given out at JNSHS Awards Night.
