2024 JNSHS P & C Annual General Meeting President's Report

Thank you all for attending tonight.

2024 saw the P & C support the students of James Nash State High School in a variety of different ways. This included:

- Providing funds for students who attended Creative Generations
- Contributing just over \$8,000.00 towards the Year 12 Formal. This ensures that the price of the tickets for students is kept to a minimum to allow all eligible students to attend
- Purchasing sausages for the Transition Day sausage sizzle. Transition Day is when all enrolled Year 6 students spend the day at James Nash experiencing High School.
- Purchasing sausages for a sausage sizzle organised by the Year 9 students to sell and raise funds for Starlight Foundation during Book Week.
- The purchase of the Beer Keg for the Year 12 Hospitality Students completing their Certificate III in Hospitality – staff and parents attend a small function in the evening and the students showcase their new skills.
- Providing funds for students who attended various sporting events throughout the year

We were also provided the opportunity once again to sponsor the 2025 Year 7 Scholarships. Last year 13 scholarships were awarded for Sporting, Equity, Maths/Science, English/Humanities and the Arts with each student receiving \$300.00 towards school fees and the purchase of uniforms.

At the 2024 Awards Night the P & C provided \$2,250.00 for 5 of the prizes offered including the Dux Award which was presented earlier this year.

We also donated the sum of \$4,500.00 towards the wages of the Chaplain for 2024.

The P & C also donated funds to purchase a coffee machine for the Coffee Van which was renovated by Brenno's Renos. This Coffee Van will be used by students, and staff alike, for many years to come.

2024 saw our school facilities team secure funding in the sum of approximately \$500,000.00 to be able to give the Tuckshop a much-needed makeover. This upgrade will take place later this year so stay tuned!

Finally, at the end of last year we were able to successfully negotiate with Lowes to have them take over the sale of our uniforms. This now gives busy families more opportunity to purchase uniforms with Lowes being open 7 days a week. This has meant that we have been able to recoup money that would have otherwise been tied up for a lengthy period of time. To date the funds paid to us by Lowes has been approximately \$50,000.00 with another payment expected in the near future.

I want to acknowledge the other members of the Executive Team this year – Carol, Megan and Sean and thank them for their efforts and valuable contribution this year!

This will be my last Presidents Report as I wish to resign from the position.
