<p>What if certain programs are not compatible with different operating systems?</p>	<p>JNSHS faculties will ensure that software purchases for student use will operate effectively on devices that meet the school's recommendation. <p>Does the school have a measure of control over which programs and software are used on the laptops?</p>	<p>The school has policy regarding the appropriate use of computers and mobile devices at school and students are required to comply with that policy. Inappropriate content, including games with ratings not suited to the age of the student; is not acceptable on devices used at school. The school's internet and email systems are filtered to assist in the management of appropriate content from these systems.</p>
<p>Will I have to buy additional software too?</p>	<p>Heads of Departments for affected faculties will provide advice to their students on how to access the required software. Students may be required to download free software. Students will not be required to purchase software for prescribed school tasks however parents may need to grant permission for school technicians to install such software.</p>
