

## *Principles for JNSHS P&C Subsidy for School Representatives*

---

### **Rationale:**

Whilst applauding the achievements of students at James Nash State High School, the JNSHS P&C recognises the economic impacts that affect potential student representation in state, national and international arenas. To support the academic, cultural, citizenship and QSSSSA sporting opportunities provided to our students, the P&C offers the following subsidies for representative (participatory and/or competitive) teams and individuals:

### **Representation of school at regional event:**

- No subsidy applicable

### **Representation of school/region at state event:**

- Up to \$50 per student to a maximum of \$500 annually per event.

### **Representation of school/region/state at national event:**

- Up to \$100 per student to a maximum of \$750 annually per event.

### **Representation of school/region/state/nation at international event:**

- Up to \$150 per student to a maximum of \$1000 annually per event.

### **Application Process:**

The coordinating teacher must supply details of the activity including level of representations (state, national, international), the names of students participating at that level and for sporting activities, confirm the QSSSSA nature of the sport.

Subsidy applications must be lodged by the parent/guardian. Letters of request must be received by the P&C no later than 2 general meetings after the event. In the event that a representative student does not have a guardian, the letter is to be signed on the student's behalf by the school principal. Each application is to be in written format and addressed to the JNSHS P&C. The application should include the student's name, representative activity, the event date and school teacher/s involved.

### **Notification of Successful Application:**

Successful applicants will be notified by mail. All subsidies will be provided by not negotiable cheque, written in the applicant's name. Representatives are requested to provide feedback to the P&C about their participation in the subsidised activity.

*Event* = single academic, cultural, citizenship or sporting activity that originates from participation in JNSHS curricula or extra-curricula offerings

*Representation* = participation through nomination and selection process or progression via success or selection in competition
